

## TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

1-0 IM A Cup is prohibiting any and all alcohol from the premises of the event. This includes the parking lot. If you bring it in your car, do NOT open it and do NOT consume it on the property! We will be very vigilant about policing this matter. If any of the rink or tournament staff observes any alcohol anywhere on the property of the rink, we will call the police immediately. NO EXCEPTIONS! The rink is private property and they have every right to prohibit the presence of alcohol on their property. None of us hockey players should be drinking when we are playing anyways, so this should not be an issue for anyone.

2-We will very closely monitor anybody that is not a participant in the event. They will also be subject to the restrictions above. Please use your judgment as to who you bring to the rink with you. This is what we believe resulted in the vandalism in the first place which has resulted in these restrictions.

3-All teams will now be required to pay an additional \$25 REFUNDABLE deposit with their entry fee. At the conclusion of the event, at the discretion of the event and rink staff, all teams will be refunded the money should it be determined that no significant damage has occurred. I will walk the premises with the rink staff to determine if there is any damage that can be linked to the tournament participants. I don't see any reason why this deposit won't be refunded after every event, but the rink will not allow us to continue to host events without this stipulation.

4- IF WE ALL WORK TOGETHER to make sure that vandalism of the facility does not happen, we will be allowed to continue to play in these fun events and I am sure the damage deposit will go away after we have proven that the vandalism will not recur. Let's all use good judgment with who we bring to these events and continue to have the outstanding fun that we always at these events. If you see anyone in violation of the above rules at an event, please bring it to the attention of the tournament or rink staff and we will handle the situation without naming you as the "informant".
